Hampshire County Council encourage all Infant School pupils to enjoy a school meal at lunchtime as it supports afternoon concentration and learning. This applies to all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Each child is entitled to a hot, two course meal at school which will include a meat or non-meat main item, vegetables, potato, pasta or rice, or a Jacket Potato with various toppings. All options are available with salad and a dessert.
