YEAR 2 TRIP TO PETER ASHLEY ACTIVITY CENTRE



With only 6 weeks to go for your child here at Padnell Infants, we wanted to share with you an “end of journey” treat. We have arranged for the children to visit the Peter Ashley Activity Centre, paid for in full by School. Each class will be attending on a different day but the whole year group will get to participate in this additional experience.

Children will take part in Archery, Bouldering and a string trail. The children will travel by minibus, which will be fitted with seatbelts, leaving school at 9.15am, returning for the end of the school day. Therefore, **all children will require a packed lunch** (no chocolate or sweets). As usual, we will provide you with a recycled brown paper bag in which to send your child’s lunch. This enables all rubbish to be thrown away. Please ensure your child brings their named, clear plastic school water bottle (metal bottles are not suitable in school). **For trips only, it is acceptable for this to be juice or squash (no fizzy drinks).** If you would like Dolce to provide a packed lunch, please pre-order this on SchoolGrid as you would usually do a school meal.

Although no payment is required, we still need you to give your permission on Arbor by **Friday 5th June.**

- No uniform required.

- Trainers or suitable footwear for bad weather (nature walk will proceed regardless of weather)
- Please ensure you apply suncream
- Bring a lightweight coat
- No spending money needed
- No book bags are needed
